

CLERK'S REPORT – PARISH COUNCIL 11 OCTOBER 2021.
Report on actions taken on resolutions made at the last meeting:

104.21 Community Safety – a new PCSO has been appointed to Upton; I have asked that crime reports do not include data from the CoCH.

108.21 NDP – see agenda item for further consideration of the proposed PC Action List.

109.21 Nature Recovery Corridor – as requested, I have invited representatives of Chester Zoo to attend the next meeting to present information on the Nature Recovery Corridor.

As requested, I have written to Cllr Bryan to ask for a written report to the PC on Borough Council matters that affect Upton.

111.12 Remembrance Parade – this event is in-hand; Cllr Bennion will provide an update at the meeting.

A written risk assessment will be in place at the request of our insurers – I am awaiting final details of the event in order to assess the risks.

112.21 Tree Planting – a very useful site visit has taken place with representative of CW&C Council and Cllrs; trees from the residential home development will be planted in a semi-formal 'avenue' adjacent to the Cheshire railings. An 'edible' woodland will be planted in the areas outlined and approved previously. Further discussions regarding the creation of a pond took place – see agenda item.

115.21 Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee Carnival – this item has been referred to the General Purposes Cttee. Four Upton residents have put themselves forward to plan and manage the carnival parade.

116.21 Christmas Carols event – the annual Christmas Carol singing event will take place on Thursday 9 December.
