

Clerk's Report – General Purposes Committee Meeting 21 June 2021.

Report on actions taken on the resolutions of the meeting held on 08 March 2021.

4. Cycle Plan for Upton – this project has now been taken in hand by the Love Your Upton part of the STTF.

5. Pavilion – see agenda item for further consideration. The Pavilion has been open for shop and bathroom facilities only since 29 March.

7. Bowling Green – Upton Bowling Club members have paid individual membership to UPC for this season.

After taking advice from UPC insurers, I have advised UBC that whilst they are covered as 'hirers' at Upton bowling green, guests of the club playing league matches are not. UBC are not covered by UPC insurance when playing at other bowling greens.

A discussion with the Chairman of UBC to consider a merger with UPC to form a new bowling club at the end of this season has taken place. It has been agreed to wait until the end of the season and hold a meeting of members of the club and the Parish Council to discuss further.

8. Defibrillators in phone boxes – there is no official record or 'directory' of defibrillators available. Local knowledge does not seem to indicate that further defibrillators would not be beneficial.

The telephone defib project needs to be costed properly.



I thought you might be interested to know that The Royal British Legion and The Poppy Appeal is commemorating its Centenary on 15th May this year. This is an anniversary we hold dear in West Cheshire particularly as The Legion was started not too far from us in Birkenhead. The Legion was formed to support servicemen and women, ex-serving personnel and their families. In 2021, The Royal British Legion is still supporting those who serve through the Funds raised with its well-loved Poppy Appeal.

I am currently offering Lamppost Poppies which have proved very popular during the Poppy Appeal. However, local communities might like to use them to commemorate this special event and show their support during this time. The suggested donation for Individuals and Shops is £5 each unit (lower for bulk orders for Councils etc.). The £5 includes a sponsor sign and a Certificate of Appreciation. Each Poppy is 40cm x 33 cm approx. The Suggested donation for Councils etc. is £3 for bulk orders over. The Lamppost Poppies can usually be re-used later in the year to show support for the Poppy Appeal
