

CLERK'S REPORT – PARISH COUNCIL 18 January 2021.

Report on actions taken on resolutions made at the last meeting:

81.20 STTF – see agenda item.

84.20 Community Notice Board – the new notice board is now in place and in use by members of Upton community.

87.20 Budget – the tax base figures have been received and circulated. The Finance Committee will make a recommendation to the meeting – see agenda item.

88.20 NDP – actions are ongoing to consult with Upton residents regarding the draft plan. Some discussion regarding the Parish Council Action List is ongoing – see agenda item.

Formal Complaint Against Cllr – the formal complaint has been withdrawn.

89.20 Live Streaming Meetings – I am awaiting further information from Cllr Walker.

90.20 Public Speaking at Meetings – despite the resolution of the Parish Council to permit public speaking at full PC meetings but not committee meetings, I am still receiving requests for this. Committee meetings are restricted to 1 hour in length and deal with many decisions/actions. I am responding to requests to speak at committee meetings by inviting written information that I will circulate to committee members.

92.20 Flooding at Marl Heys – I have responded further to the residents at Marl Heys; I have been unable so far to reach anyone at Sanctuary Housing to discuss possible solutions. I will report further at the meeting.

93.20 Cycling Plan for Upton – this matter was further considered at the General Purposes Committee meeting of 11 January. A report will be given at the meeting.
