Welcome to your NEW Parish Council

What's been going on?

Well, on May 4th 2023, we had Borough Council and Parish Council elections.

There were sixteen seats on the Parish Council, divided between the five wards of Upton Heath (7); Upton Grange (5); Upton Park (2); Bache (1) and Moston (1).

In May, eight candidates stood for election, and soon after, two stepped down. After the process of co-option (where residents may fill casual vacancies arising between elections), a further six councilors were appointed, then a further two stepped down, so the Parish Council currently has ten members.

Upton also elected two Borough Councillors to represent our interests on Cheshire West and Chester Council. Our Borough Councillors, Cllr Sherin Akhtar and Cllr Matt Bryan, were also elected to the Parish Council and provide us with a good insight of what happens at the higher level.

Plea for additional Councillors

There are still six seats to fill. If you feel you can bring something to our Upton community and have some time, please get in touch.

If you have fresh ideas about how the Parish Council should be working in Upton, please do join us. We don't agree on everything, as you might expect, but it does lead us into some great debates.

You will receive a very warm welcome when you attend a Parish Council meeting. Occasionally for sensitive items such as employment matters, we may exclude the public from parts of a meeting, but not often. Meeting dates, times, agendas, and minutes are available on the website.

What have we been doing?

We have put in quite a few hours recently to making sure that the Parish Council is managing its cash, reserves, staff, land, and facilities responsibly - so the first few months have been about putting in place some important foundations to ensure that your Parish Council is in excellent shape.

We have improved our management around health and safety, employment, and finance, and have started to develop a Strategic Plan – and we will be asking you very shortly to contribute to a shared vision.
