### Speeding in Upton –

We have been enforcing the speed limit on A41 Long Lane with the TruCam and fines and penalty points sent out. We also been out measuring speeds on Caughall Road after complaints of speeding

**Parking Outside Glastonbury Avenue** – We have received several complaints regarding inconsiderate parking on this street. I have attended and issued fines to vehicles blocking the footpath

**ASB at Forest School Mill View** - Youths have been gaining entry to the forest school and setting fire to wooden equipment within the school ground

**ASB Pavilion** – Youths have caused damage to the safety flooring at the park – We are waiting for the CCTV to be burnt onto a disc for us to seize to investigate.
